BIANCO is based on Piedmont white wines, and infused with dozens different botanicals from the nearby Occitan Alps.

EXTRA DRY is a more restrained version, mainly infused with camomile and juniper. a more serious vermouth.

FUTURE PERFECT Bitter Moon Hobart/Lutruwita, Tasmania

Pinot and chardy pressings, medium sweetness. Botanicals native and not, some homegrown at FP. Sip, swirl it. Spritz it.

LUSTAU Jerez 14

The 'Sherry Triangle' of Andalusia, southern Spain, where local (and rare) air creates a waxy, foamy live flor, whose thickness dictates the oxidative nature of the short, luxurious and famous aperitif.

Each of these three LUSTAU (Jerez OG) represent the different styles, flavours from the tripex of the 'Sherry Triangle'.

FINO Jerez - Intense golden colour with amber reflections. Pungent nose. Yeast, white bread, chalk and butter nuances.

FINO El Puerto de Santa Maria - dry, but dry-rich, broad on palate. Almonds. Bright golden.

MANZANILLA Sanlúcar de Barrameda - dry, bright, fresh; notes of seaspray.

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CABERNET SAUVIGNON

From its regality of Bordeaux, Cabernet Sauvignon is, truly, the king of wines. Thanks to a major river system that famously splits Bordeaux into two sub-regions, and sub regional styles (Left Bank - Cabernet-based wine; and Right Bank, where merlot is either bottled as a single variety or as its dominant grape). Classified by wine law in 1855, somehow it has fallen out of favour in the last 50 years (much to do with the popular advent of chardonnay, pinot and shiraz). But due as much to its sexy new shorthand (BDX) as well as cycles of style, BDX will soon be back in the dress circle...
