## CABERNET SAUVIGNON

*From its regality of Bordeaux, Cabernet Sauvignon is, truly, the king of wines. Thanks to a major river system that famously splits Bordeaux into two sub-regions, and sub regional styles (Left Bank - Cabernet-based wine; and Right Bank, where merlot is either bottled as a single variety or as its dominant grape). Classified by wine law in 1855, somehow it has fallen out of favour in the last 50 years (much to do with the popular advent of chardonnay, pinot and shiraz). But due as much to its sexy new shorthand (BDX) as well as cycles of style, BDX will soon be back in the dress circle...*
